

Physical Therapy & Sports Medicine Insurance Benefit Verification Notice

Skyline Hospital understands that navigating health insurance coverage can be overwhelming and confusing. Before you make your first appointment, we strongly encourage you to contact your insurance company to clarify your insurance coverage as it relates to physical therapy. On the back of your insurance card you will find a phone number or website. Here are a few recommendations to make the process easier:

- To determine if Skyline Hospital is in your insurance network, please use the title "Klickitat County Public Hospital District No. 2." This is our official title in the insurance industry.
- Notify them that Skyline Hospital Physical Therapy & Sports Medicine is a "hospital-based outpatient physical therapy facility," which is a department of Skyline Hospital.
- Ask if there is a difference in coverage for hospital-based outpatient physical therapy vs privately owned outpatient facilities.

To help estimate the cost of your care, please ask about the following:

- Deductible amount
- Number of visits allowed
- Co-pay insurance amount
- Co-insurance amount
- Authorization requirements
